This event name was presented as Stillwater Balloon Rally. Marsha spoke about parking and the schedule of the event. She provided a map of parking and a copy of event schedule. Marsha informed the Council that the Airport Board, Fire Department and Police Department had all be informed of the event idea and all departments are in favor of the event. Mayor informed Marsha and Rich Cowger of the insurance issue. Mayor read the Airport's insurance policy rider and explained that the current insurance that the Airport has will not cover this event. Rich will bring this new information to the Airport Boards attention. City Attorney stated that there will need to be an entity other than the city or county that will provide insurance for this event. Marsha stated once there is a sponsorship for the event, they will possibly be able to provide the proper insurance. Council all agreed that this would be a great event for the city, but no decision will be made on the approval of the application for Special Use Permit until the issue with the insurance is handled.

NEW BUSINESS	Rich Cowger, Board Member of the Airport Board, presented Council with proposed drawing of 12 T-Hangars that would be built at the Airport along with a report of the projected cost of the construction of said T-Hangars. Rich explained to Council the current funds available for the project along with the future revenue the T-Hangars would generate. Rich proposed that the additional funds needed to complete the project could be provided by the City and County via loans. Bob Fitzgerald asked if the projected cost of project would stay on track, or would there be a possibility of a major overage? Rich ensured Bob that the engineers that bid these projects do a great job of allocating for budget overages so that shouldn't be a problem. Rich mentioned the possibility of having 2 phases of construction depending on funding. Tim Mayo asked what the additional impact be on the budget if it was completed in 2 phases? Rich said there would definitely be additional cost to having 2 phases of construction but would have the engineers prepare 2 options for review. Mayor spoke of all the major infrastructure projects that are in the near future for the City and advised Rich to lean towards the option of 2 phases. City is not in the position to help with funding for this project at this time. City Attorney advised council to vote on a permission to allow Airport Board to seek bids on the construction of 12 T-Hangars with options of two phases 6 or 12.
